Statement of Response

Following consultation feedback on our draft DWMP, our statement of response can now be found on our website [here](#).

The document summarises feedback across customers, stakeholders and regulators. The feedback has been categorised into key themes. These include:

- Options development, programme optimisation and the preferred plan;
- Stakeholder engagement and partnership solutions;
- Customer acceptability;
- Storm overflows;
- Wider strategic ambition of the DWMP; and
- DWMP document structure and content.

The feedback throughout the consultation process will support the development of the final DWMP and the approach for future cycles.

DWMP Geospatial Platform (GSP)

In order to share our plan in an interactive format, we have produced an online GSP to publish the DWMP.

The DWMP GSP has been developed in three levels and this tailored approach to data sharing will facilitate effective and successful partnership working, whilst allowing us to protect customers where more sensitive information must be shared.
